

POSTDOCTORAL FELLOWSHIP OPPORTUNITY IN PARIS Environmental Cancer Epidemiology

The Cancer and Environment Team of the CESP (Center for Research in Epidemiology and Population Health), Inserm (<http://cesp.inserm.fr/>) is seeking a candidate for a post-doctoral research fellowship position. The initial appointment will be for 1 or 2 years, with possibility of renewal thereafter.

Our research program in Cancer Epidemiology is wide-ranging, with an emphasis on the study of the environmental and occupational risk factors of cancers, characterization of exposures to carcinogens in the population, and study of genetic factors and gene-environment interactions.

We have a position for a postdoctoral fellow interested in studies of environmental risk factors in cancer. The successful applicant will join our team to conduct statistical analyses of large epidemiological studies on breast and respiratory cancers and to study the health impact of environmental exposures in France. The postdoctoral fellow will work closely with scientists specialized in cancer epidemiology or air pollution effects.

The candidate should have a PhD in Epidemiology or Biostatistics. Experience in cancer epidemiology, air pollution epidemiology, or genetic/epigenetic epidemiology would be an asset. The candidate is expected to have excellent analytical and oral communication skills, good publication record, and have a sense of teamwork. French speaking is a plus, but is not required.

The successful candidate will be employed by Inserm (Institut National de la Santé et de la Recherche Médicale), an internationally renowned French organization dedicated to biological research and human health. The place of work will be in Villejuif, close to Paris, in the Cancer and Environment team of the CESP, the main Inserm unit dedicated to Public Health Research.
